

AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH AND REGULATE THE SPEED ZONES ON TOWN ROADS THAT LIE IN THE TOWN OF LANARK, COUNTY OF PORTAGE, STATE OF WISCONSIN.

ORDINANCE NO. 11-84

The Town of Lanark Town Board, County of Portage, State of Wisconsin, do hereby ordain as follows:

Section I

The maximum permissible speed at which vehicles may be operated on said highway which speed is herewith established as reasonable and safe pursuant to Section 346.57(4) (g) and Chapter 213, Laws of 1979, Wisconsin Statutes, shall be as set forth herein, subject to the erection of standard signs given notice thereof.

The speed limit for all vehicles on the following described portion of town roads in the Town of Lanark shall be twenty five (25) miles per hour.

1. Boelter Lake Road from its intersection with County Trunk Highway "A", westerly to its terminus, a distance of 0.73 of a mile.
2. Boelter Lake Court from its intersection with Boelter Lake Road, northerly to its terminus, a distance of 0.13 of a mile.
3. Boelter Lake Lane from its intersection with Boulder Lake Road, northerly to its terminus, a distance of 0.18 of a mile.
4. Pine Drive from its intersection with Boulder Lake Road, northerly, northeasterly, westerly and southeasterly for a distance of 0.79 of a mile.
5. Oak hills Drive from is intersection with County Trunk Highway "N", southerly to its terminus, a distance of .36 of a mile

Section II

Any person violating any provision of this ordinance may be required to forfeit not less than twenty dollars (\$20.00) nor more than two hundred dollars (\$200.00)
