

COMPREHENSIVE PLAN ORDINANCE

Ordinance No. 8-05

The Town Board of the Town of Lanark, Portage County, Wisconsin, do ordain as follows:

Section One:

This Ordinance is entitled "Comprehensive Plan Ordinance." Pursuant to Section 62.23(2) and (3) of the Wisconsin Statutes, the Town of Lanark is authorized to prepare and adopt a Comprehensive Plan as defined in Section 66.1001(1)(a) and 66.1001(2) of the Wisconsin Statutes.

Section Two:

The Plan Commission of the Town of Lanark has been working cooperatively with the assistance of the Portage County Planning and Zoning Department in preparing a Comprehensive Plan for the Town as part of a multi-jurisdictional planning effort.

Section Three:

The Town Board of the Town of Lanark has adopted written procedures designed to foster public participation in every stage of the preparation of a Comprehensive Plan as required by Section 66.1001(4)(a) of the Wisconsin Statutes.

Section Four:

The Plan Commission of the Town of Lanark by a majority vote of the entire Commission recorded in its official minutes, has adopted a resolution recommending to the Town Board the adoption of the document entitled "2005 Comprehensive Plan of the Town of Lanark", containing all of the elements specified in Section 66.1001(2) of the Wisconsin Statutes.

Section Five:

The Town held public hearings on July 19, 2005 and July 23, 2005 regarding the proposed adoption of the Comprehensive Plan, in compliance with the requirements of Section 66.1001(4)(d) of the Wisconsin Statutes.

Section Six:

The Town Board of the Town of Lanark, Portage County, Wisconsin, does, by enactment of this Ordinance, formally adopt the document entitled, "2005 Comprehensive Plan of the Town of Lanark", pursuant to Section 66.1001(4)(c) of the Wisconsin Statutes.

Section Seven:

This Ordinance shall take effect upon passage by a majority vote of the members-elect of the Town Board and be posted as required by law.
