

**CULVERT PLACEMENT ORDINANCE**  
ORDINANCE NO. 8-94

This Ordinance is entitled the "Town of Lanark Culvert Placement Ordinance". The purpose of this Ordinance is to preserve Town road quality by determining those access sites along Town roads that are in need of culverts.

The Town Board of the Town of Lanark do ordain as follows:

1. When applications for Building Permits are made to the Portage County Planning and Zoning Department, and when such building sites have access off Town roads, then the Portage County Planning and Zoning Department shall contact any Town of Lanark Board member who shall then inspect the site (with or without other Board members) and inform the applicant if a culvert is necessary.
2. When any existing access site to private property along a Town road is shown to warrant the placement of a culvert, then the Town of Lanark Board may so request the owner to install a culvert.

Criteria to determine the need for a culvert shall be based upon slope, ditch depth, water flow and other such criteria upon the discretion of the Board.

When such culverts are deemed necessary, then the property owner shall assume financial responsibility for such placement.

This Ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication as provided by law.
