

TOWN OF LANARK ORDINANCE NO. 4-5-93
RE: TOWN FIRE NUMBER PLACEMENT

WHEREAS, the Town of Lanark seeks to establish a consistent policy for the placement of fire numbers on residents' property; and

WHEREAS, the placement of such numbers is to be for the benefit of Fire Departments and First Responder Units;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED by the Town of Lanark Board as follows:

1. Tile fire numbers are to be placed by a designated Town employee, on a steel post set in the ground in close proximity to the main entrance of the resident's dwelling, facing the main road and free of visual obstructions.
2. In the case of dead-end roads with three or less residents, fire numbers are to be arranged on a single post placed at that road's entrance.
3. In the case of a subdivision with one main entrance road or a dead-end road with four or more residents, the numbers are to be placed facing the road's entrance.
4. If a fire number is lost or damaged the resident is responsible for reporting the loss to the Town Board and shall be liable for all costs incurred in replacing the fire number.
