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The Lanark Town Plan Commission met at The Lanark Town Hall on Thursday, September 2, 2010, at 9:00 a.m. Commission members Pat Wollering, Nancy Turyk (enter 9:06 a.m.), Marlene Sannes, and Gene Peterson, Alternate Ida Frizzell, Secretary Cheryl Leatherman, 2 residents and 1 guest were present.

The meeting was called to order by P. Wollering at 9:05 a.m.

BUSINESS

1. The Commission reviewed the minutes from the August 5, 2010 Plan Commission meeting. Motion by N. Turyk seconded by P. Wollering to approve the minutes as written and carried 4-0-0.
2. The Commission discussed the request by Harold & Taffy Morgan, 10262 County Road T, Amherst, to split parcel 022-22-1003-15.08, 27.87 acres zoned A2. Motion by N. Turyk seconded by M. Sannes to recommend the Town Board accept the split as presented and carried 4-0-0.
3. The Commission discussed the bed and breakfast at the 9874 County Road K educational facility owned by Robert & Marguerite Ramlow. Motion by M. Sannes seconded by P. Wollering and carried 3-0-1 (N. Turyk abstained) to recommend the Town Board write a letter to the Portage County Board of Adjustment asking if the bed and breakfast at 9874 County Road K is adhering to the conditions set forth at the May 21, 2007 Board of Adjustment meeting as there appears at this time to be more of a broader use than what was presented and therefore approved.
4. Motion to adjourn at 10:05 a.m. was made by G. Peterson seconded by N. Turyk and carried 4-0-0.
