

## **VILLAGE POWERS ORDINANCE**

#5-94

This ordinance is entitled the "Town of Lanark Village Powers Ordinance."

The Town Board of the Town of Lanark, with certain actions of the annual Town meeting or any special Town meeting in the Town of Lanark, pursuant to Sec. 60.10(2) WI Statutes, may obtain, by resolution, the right for the Town Board of the Town of Lanark to exercise, pursuant to Sec. 60.22 WI Statutes, powers of a village board under Chapter 61, WI Statutes, except that the Town Board of the Town of Lanark cannot exercise for those village board powers which conflict with statutes relating to Towns and Town Boards. This resolution, by the Town meeting, is to be general and continuing. This grant of legislative and administrative power to the Town Board of the Town of Lanark is to be known as "village powers".

The Town meeting of the Town of Lanark dated April 16, 1994 did authorize, by adoption of a resolution, and the Town Board of the Town of Lanark does, by adoption of this ordinance, confirm that the Town Board of the Town of Lanark has the specific authority, powers and duties noted above in Chapter 60 and 61, WI Statutes, and has established pursuant to these chapter and this ordinance the powers and duties of the Town Board of the Town of Lanark to exercise village board powers pursuant to Sec. 60.22 and 61.34, WI Statutes, and subject to the conditions established in Sec. 60.22, WI Statutes.
